DEPOT FOR THE ELECTRIC BRT SERVICES IN MAPUTO**

INTRODUCTION

The Ministry of Transport and Communications (MTC) is inviting Expressions of Interest (EOI) from qualified and experienced Consultancy Firms to provide “Consultancy Services for Design and Supervision of the Construction Works of a Depot for the Electric BRT Services in Maputo” The EOI will lead to a Request for Proposal (RFP) for the below-mentioned Consultancy Services package from the short-listed Consultants.

BACKGROUND

The Government of Mozambique, represented by the Ministry of Transport and Communications, has received financing from the World Bank toward the cost of the Maputo Metropolitan Area Urban Mobility Project, and intends to apply part of the proceeds for consulting services.

The specific objective of the assignment is preparation studies and tests, and the detailed architectural, environmental and engineering design for the Construction of a DEPOT and of a Holding facility, and to carry out the supervision of Construction Works.

The consulting services (the Services) include, but not limited to (1) Review the proposed DEPOT and Holding Area functional layouts, optimizing it for fast, high-quality operations; (2) Design light service facilities such as washing, lubrication, cleaning, tires and other functions that are part of the daily maintenance and cleaning routines for each of the 110 buses that the DEPOT can accommodate; (3) Design changing rooms, showers and toilet facilities, restroom, cafeteria, reception and dispatch area, for drivers and bus operational staff, at the DEPOT and the Holding Area; (4) Design the shaded bus parking and the bus dispatch areas, at the DEPOT and Holding Areas, etc.

SCOPE OF SERVICES

The Ministry of Transport and Communications now invites eligible consulting firms (Consultants) to indicate their interest in providing the Services. Interested Consultants should provide information demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the Services.

The consulting firm that is to be selected shall have its core business and experience as consultancy in design and supervision in the BRT Depot, CBD Holding Area and Control Centre. Must be an officially registered consulting firm on its country of origin. The short-listing criteria will be as follows:

(i) Core Business: experience as consultancy in design and supervision BRT Depot, CBD Holding Area and Control Centre, over the last 10 years; (ii) experience in prepare tender/procurement documents for service providers to the DEPOT and Holding Area, namely of electricity, ICT network services, ISP network services, communications and liquid fuel supplies (for working vehicles), over the last 10 years; (iii) Provide information necessary for the execution of the services, providing the conditions for the Design and Supervision Consultant to fulfill the contract; (iv) experience over the last 10 years in Supervision of Construction works relating to projects in the field of urban mass transport (Metro, Tramway, BRT, bus, etc.); (v) Provide information necessary for compliance with environmental and social Standards, over the last 10 years;

Key Experts will not be evaluated at the shortlisting stage.

The Consultancy will have a duration of 23 months, plus 365 days of defect liability period, from the effectiveness day of the assignment.

Consultants may associate with other firms to enhance their qualifications but should indicate clearly whether the association is in the form of a joint venture and/or a sub-consultancy. Any party to the association, either joint venture member's or sub-contractor's experience will count on the qualifications criteria. In the case of a Joint Venture (JV), the Consultant shall specify the lead partner and all the partners in the joint venture shall be jointly and severally liable for the entire contract, if selected.

The attention of interested Consultants is drawn to paragraph 3.14 to 3.17 of the World Bank's Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers dated July 2016, revised in November 2017, August 2018, November 2020, and September 2023 setting forth the World Bank's Policy on Conflict of Interest.

A Consultant will be selected in accordance with the Quality and Cost-based Selection (QCBS) method set out in the World Bank Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers. Only shortlisted Consultants will be approached directly by Ministry of Transport and Communications (MTC) to submit proposals for the services required in the RFP phase.
