1. The Government of Mozambique, represented by the Ministry of Transport and Logistics has received financing from the World Bank toward the cost of the Maputo Metropolitan Area Urban Mobility Project (MMAUMP), and intends to apply part of the proceeds toward payments under the contract for Construction of BRT infrastructure). For this contract, the Borrower shall process the payments using the Direct Payment disbursement method, as defined in the World Bank's Disbursement Guidelines for Investment Project Financing.
2. The Ministry of Transport and Logistics now invites sealed Bids from eligible Bidders for Civil Works Contract to be performed in the Municipalities of Maputo, Matola and Marracuene related to (i) the construction of a segregated running way for the BRT service that is 22km long inclusive of rehabilitation of mixed traffic lanes; (ii) the construction of stations, bus stops and terminals; and (iii) the installation of systems and equipment for passenger information and fleet management. The works will be a single lot and have a duration of 24 months. Margin of preference will not be applicable.
3. Bidding will be conducted through international competitive procurement using Request for Bids (RFB) as specified in the World Bank's "Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers- Procurement in Investment Projects Financing" edition March 2025 ("Procurement Regulations"), and is open to all eligible Bidders as defined in the Procurement Regulations.
4. Bids will be evaluated in accordance with the evaluation process set out in the bidding documents. The following weightings shall apply for Rated Criteria (including technical and non-price factors): 60% and for the Bid cost: 40%.
5. The outer Bid envelopes marked “ORIGINAL BID,” and the inner envelopes marked “TECHNICAL PART” will be publicly opened in the presence of the Bidders’ designated representatives and anyone who chooses to attend, at the address below on the Meeting Room of the MMAUMP, at 10:30 AM local time, on 30<sup>th</sup> July 2025. All envelopes marked “FINANCIAL PART” shall remain unopened and will be held in safe custody of the Employer until the second public Bid opening.
8. All Bids must be accompanied by a Bid Security of 2,000,000.00 United States dollars.
9. All Bids must be accompanied by a Sexual Exploitation and Abuse (SEA) and/or Sexual Harassment (SH) Declaration.
10. Attention is drawn to the Procurement Regulations requiring the Borrower to disclose information on the successful bidder’s beneficial ownership, as part of the Contract Award Notice, using the Beneficial Ownership Disclosure Form as included in the bidding document.
