3 **Description**

The Ministry of Transport and Logistics (MTL), through the Project Portfolio Coordination Unit (UCP) invites you to participate in an Early Market Engagement (EME) session for the upcoming procurement package for implementation of following projects: (a) **MMAUMP - Maputo Metropolitan Area Urban Mobility Project** aiming to improve mobility and accessibility along selected corridor in the Maputo Metropolitan Area; (b) **CRRN - Climate Resilient Roads for the North** targeted to strengthen the climate resilience of road infrastructure and improve safe, all-season access for communities in Mozambique's northern provinces, (c) **TRACER SOP2 - Transport Corridors for Economic Resilience** to improve regional trade and transport connectivity, logistics efficiency, and road safety along the Nacala Corridor; and (d) **SRSEIP -Safer Roads for Socio-Economic Integration Program** to improve road connectivity, safety, and climate resilience in the Program areas

4 **Brief description**

The main works activities across the four projects is as detailed:

a) MMAUMP - Maputo Metropolitan Area Urban Mobility Project

Construction of a Depot for the electric Bus Rapid Transfer (BRT) Services in Maputo, procurement BRT e-buses and rolling stock, installation of BRT Digital Systems, including ITS, AFC and Technology Integration Solutions, Bus Operations and Concession Management and maintenance Services, Depot operation including potential Public-Private Partnership (PPP) opportunities and engagement with public transport operator associations.

b) CRRN - Climate Resilient Roads for the North

Acquisition of 2000m of metallic bridges for post-climatic disaster response, upgrading to paved standard 47km of the Tertiary Road R760 Muxara – Mecufi; upgrading to paved standard 25km of the Tertiary Road R762 Muepane – Metugi; and construction of Rio Lurio bridge (560 m) along the N1 road in Cabo Delgado province;

c) TRACER SOP2 - Transport Corridors for Economic Resilience

Rehabilitation and upgrading of road N360 Cuamba - Metarica (67km); rehabilitation and upgrading of Rapale - Mecuburi road (57.23km), Consultancy services and roads rehabilitation works for climate Risk and vulnerability reduction alongside the Nacala Corridor, civil works for road safety improvements at schools and locations along the Nacala Corridor with an iRAP Rating Less Than Three Stars and consultancy the ESIA/RAP studies and supervision services.

d) SRSEIP -Safer Roads for Socio-Economic Integration Program

Rehabilitation of the N1 Corridor, Chimuará - Nicoadala Lot 1 (0 - 88km) road, rehabilitation of the N1 Corridor, Chimuará - Nicoadala Lot 2 (88 - 176km), rehabilitation of 30km of paved primary road N14 Metoro – Montepuez, rehabilitation of 50 km of N1 feeder roads, civil works for road safety improvements at schools and locations along the N1 road with an RAP Rating Less than three Stars
